Topic	Content	Teaching Time (estimated)
My life, my school, my routine	Report on your life. Revision of year 10.	2 weeks
A dream weekend	Talking about the past. Language focus: the past tense.	3-4 weeks
Holidays	Discuss and write about a past holiday. Present your holiday in a chosen format. . Language focus: imperfect and perfect tenses	4 weeks
Connections	. Talk about people's character and express emotion. Discuss characters on television series Language focus: Adjectives and words for arguments	4 weeks
Health	Talk about health problems. Language focus: the past tense with etre.	3 weeks
My childhood and a film	Talking about past memories, our childhoods. Discuss a popular French film.	3 weeks
Eat well and live well	Talk about food, ordering in a restaurant, customs around food.	3 weeks
Noumea or Wellington?	Talk about your country and city. Discovering the French pacific islands.	8 weeks
