Topic	Content	Teaching Time (estimated)
School System	Talking about the Japanese school system. Describing the Japanese school system, our school, and those in our school	6 weeks
Travel & Leisure	Talking about leisure activities, part-time jobs and activities one does after school. Describing preferences, comparing interests.	5 weeks
Homestay	Talk about home life in Japan, chores and responsibilities. Describing rules, and how to do things at home.	5 weeks
Eat well, live well	Talk about shopping for food, diets, healthy eating, cooking. Describe Japanese and western cuisine, comparing preferences, teaching each other how to cook.	5 weeks
Festivals & Customs	Talking about how things used to be, describe customs and rituals.	5 weeks
Story telling	Talk about Japanese anime and manga describe Japanese traditions, routines and views. Compare and give opinions about Japanese culture	2 weeks
Film study	Listening and reading practice to help prepare for the exams	3 weeks

- All topics prepare students for the externally assessed standards 2.1 (Listening) and 2.4 (Reading).
- All topics provide a context for the internally assessed standards 2.3 and 2.5 (Writing)
- The remaining internal standard 2.2 (Speech) is not assessed in 2017 at Level 2.
