Assessments

Internally Assessed Standards

Achievement Standards 3.8, 3.9, 3.10 and 3.11 are internally assessed standards. The assessment of these standards is final, i.e. they will not be reassessed either during the year or in the examinations at the end of the year. All students must be able to attend at the time of the final assessment. Reassessment of any standard will be at the discretion of the coordinating teacher for MAS301.

External Standards
